Plus mated purebred Nudie ram lambs to ewes and ewe hoggets, including Nudie ew hoggets and Streaker (first cross) ewe hoggets. The first cross include mating to Wairere FE resilient ewes, to Tufguys, and to bare pointed Romneys. Streaker two tooth rams will be available in November. Ram lamb sires will be available in late February/early March.
